God: Reality or Delusion? – That is the question

Explore the facts!

WHY: It seems many people these days are searching for an answer to the question “Is there a God? Or is God just a figment of our imagination.” International speaker Daniel Scott says, “In my own experience I’ve found that God is dependable, reliable, and stands up to scientific scrutiny!”

WHAT: Scott, a member of the Christian Science Board of Lectureship, presents a lecture “**God: Reality or Delusion?**” During this talk Scott admits that misconceptions about God and the abuse of religion have led to many problems. He points out that the real solution lies, not in jettisoning religious belief altogether, but in purifying our concepts about God and our practice of religion. He goes on to provide solid and scientific grounds for faith by uprooting misconceptions about God and revealing a more credible God that can be understood (among other ways) as Truth itself, as universal Love, and as the divine spiritual Principle that underlies all that is real.

Scott’s ideas are based on the Bible (which he sees as a textbook that needs to be studied discerningly, rather than followed blindly), and the book *Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures* by Mary Baker Eddy, which brings out the scientific, timeless, and universal nature of Christianity.

During this talk audiences will:

- Learn of ways to test our beliefs about God and to turn blind belief into spiritual understanding.
- Explore a more inclusive and universal concept of God, that is credible in a scientific age.
- Discover the power of healing prayer to prove for oneself that God does indeed exist.

WHO: Scott spent seven years at Cambridge University studying mathematics and mathematical physics gaining MA in mathematics and a PhD in an abstract branch of mathematical physics. Since 1998 Scott has been working full time as a practitioner of Christian Science healing. His speaking engagements have included schools, universities, youth, church and interfaith groups. Scott travels from his home in Scarborough presenting talks around the UK.
